VII MACEDONIAN MATHEMATICAL CONGRESS

Struga, North Macedonia, June 27 – 30, 2023

Dear colleagues,

It is our pleasure to invite you to the VII Macedonian Mathematical Congress, organized by the Union of Mathematicians of Macedonia. The Congress will take place in Hotel Drim in Struga, North Macedonia, from June 27 to June 30, 2023. It is an excellent opportunity for researchers from different fields of mathematics to discuss recent advances, share ideas and promote international collaboration.

The VII Congress has an international character and is open to all areas of mathematics and its applications. Its agenda will include plenary lectures and short communications, organized in the following sections:

- 1. Real, Complex and Functional Analysis, Differential Equations
- 2. Algebra and Discrete Mathematics
- 3. Topology and Dynamical Systems
- 4. Geometry and Differential Geometry
- 5. Probability, Statistics and Applied Mathematics
- 6. Mathematics Education

Official languages of the Congress are English and Macedonian.

Participants of Sections 1–5 can publish their research articles in the oldest Macedonian mathematical journal, Matematichki Bilten (MathSciNet, Zentralblatt für Mathematik, Реферативный журнал математика, EBSCO) and participants of Section 6 in the Proceedings of the Congress.

A training seminar for teachers in primary and secondary education will be held under the following title:

STRATEGIES FOR ENCOURAGING CREATIVITY IN TEACHING MATHEMATICS

Workshops, round tables and panel discussions - NEW

School teachers will have an opportunity to attend a workshop on Testing Tests, for university - level mathematics lecturers and university students a workshop on Introduction to Data Analysis and Modeling will be organized, and all participants are welcome to take part on the round – table on Scientific and Professional Networks Involving Mathematicians. Panel discussions on The Challenges of the Mathematical Educations will also take part during Congress program.

Venue

Struga is a town situated in the south-western region of North Macedonia lying on the shore of Lake Ohrid and a popular tourist destination. It is about 12 km from the city of Ohrid (10 minutes by car). The river Crn Drim flows trough the Ohrid Lake and outflows of the lake at the city of Struga. It passes through the middle of the town, continues through Albania and flows into the Adriatic Sea. The outflow of the water near the Hotel Drim is a special attraction for every visitor. The banks of the river Crn Drim are connected with three bridges, that are ideal for a peaceful walk and enjoyment of a beautiful view along the water itself. When visiting this quiet town, there are a few other places that show its beauty and culture, like the National Museum in Struga "Dr. Nikola Nezlobinski" (with a permanent zoological collection of various animals, birds, fish and insects from the Ohrid-Prespa region), the clay chamber pots at the house of the Miladinovci Brothers, the old Struga bazaar, old churches, monasteries and mosques.

Climate. The maximum air temperatures in June vary from 20°C to 26°C, rarely falling bellow 16°C or exceeding 30°C. The water temperature can reach as high as 20 °C.
